Foundation Paper Piecing Basics Supply List

Hi! I am so excited to have you in this class! We will be using a series of FPP hexagon block patterns that I designed to make learning and mastering this technique a breeze. You only need **one** pattern for the class.

I will have the patterns available for purchase at the class along with Add-a-Quarter rulers, glue pens and refills, seam rollers, Martelli rotary cutters, and rotating cutting mats. If you would like to purchase your pattern before class, they are on my website SnapdragonQuilting.com as a PDF download you can print or physical pattern I can mail you.

Materials:

- Pattern, choose: Striped Hexi's, Equilateral Gone Awry, or Nuts About You
- 3 - 5 coordinating fabrics: $\frac{1}{4}$ to $\frac{1}{2}$ yd of each. Scraps also work well for this project. Fabrics that don't have a right side, like solids, are easier to learn FPP with but I will show you how to use prints too.
- 50 to 80 weight neutral or coordinating thread

Tools & Equipment:

- Pencil
- Colored pencils in your fabric colors (I will bring some to share)
- Paper scissors or a rotary cutter you use on paper
- Seam ripper (just in case!)
- Glue Pen such as Sewline's water soluble glue pen
- Pins
- Rotary cutter
- Add-a-Quarter ruler
- Cutting mat - small is good
- Sewing machine with a standard foot
- Quarter inch foot if you use it for $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams
- Seam Roller
- Tweezers
