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MANY MOONS AND CURVED PIECING WORKSHOP

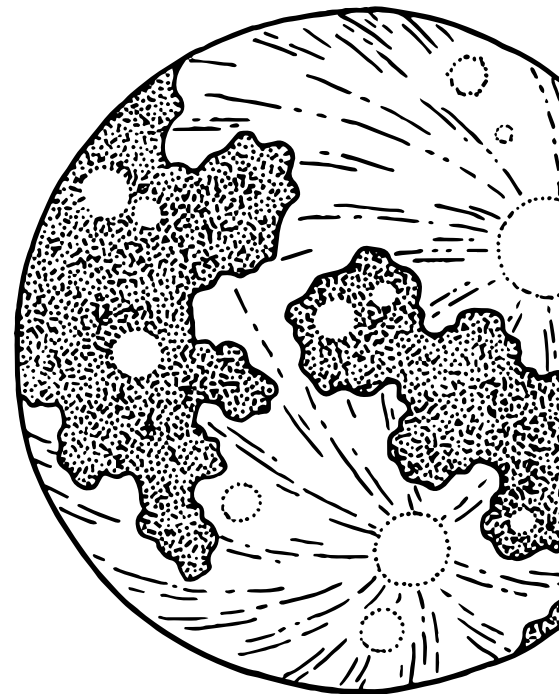
Supply List:

Materials:

- **Many Moons quilt pattern or Broken Moons quilt pattern**
- **4 Background fabrics** - 1 1/3 yds of each (2/3 yds of each for the smaller quilt), well starched.
 - From each background fabric cut four 15 1/2" (10 1/2") squares. Cut each square in half diagonally to create 32 large triangles, center blocks.
 - From each background fabric, cut out one 11" (7 1/2") square. Cut each square in half diagonally to create 8 smaller triangles, side blocks.
- **12-17 Moon fabrics** - Fat quarter or 1/4 yard of each, well starched.
- **Coordinating thread**
- **Batting, backing, and binding** are not needed for the class but will be needed to finish the quilt, refer to the pattern for yardages.

Tools & Equipment:

- Elmer's School Glue
- Freezer Paper
- Paper scissors
- Seam ripper (just in case!)
- Glue Stick such as Sewline's water soluble glue pen
- Pins
- Rotary cutter
- 8" Quilting ruler(or larger)
- Cutting mat
- Sewing machine with a quarter inch foot or standard foot
- Iron
- Ironing mat or board
- Circle Savvy Ruler by Creative Grids, optional
- Curve Master Presser Foot by Martelli, optional



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
