



# Sunshine Puff Quilt Workshop Supply List

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In this class, I'll show you how to create glowing sunbeams with simple foundation paper piecing, then we'll make those adorable puff centers that bring the sunshine to life. Choose any quilt size or just make a block or two in class.

Come have fun and leave inspired! **Everything in pink is clickable!**

## Supplies:

\*Sewing machines and cutting and ironing stations may or may not be supplied by the venue.

- Pattern: Sunshine Puff Quilt Pattern [printed version](#) or [PDF download](#)
- Fabric: White and yellow fabric, solids or tone on tone prints, refer to yardage chart in the pattern or bring the strips as listed below (this requires  $\frac{1}{2}$  yd of yellow and  $\frac{1}{3}$  yd of white).
- Fiberfil: 6oz - crib, 10oz - throw, 24oz - twin
- Coordinating [thread](#)
- Batting, backing, and binding are not needed for class but will be needed to finish the quilt, refer to the pattern for yardage.
- [Basting glue pen](#) or glue stick, washable
- [Vanishing marking pen](#)
- [Rotary Cutter](#)
- Small transparent [ruler](#) for rotary cutting
- Small [cutting mat](#)
- [Add a Quarter Plus Ruler](#)
- [Seam Roller](#)
- [Microtex \(sharp\)](#) 70/10 or 80/12 machine needle
- Hand sewing needle & thimble - your favorite
- Paper and [fabric scissors](#)
- [Pins](#)
- [Seam ripper](#) (just in case!)
- [Foundation Paper](#), optional
- [Circle Savvy Ruler](#), optional
- [Light Box](#), optional

## Before Class:

1. Order the [Sunshine Puff Quilt Pattern](#) and supplies at [SnapdragonQuilting.com](http://SnapdragonQuilting.com), or purchase them in class.
2. Print or copy your FPP templates on 20 lb copy paper or foundation piecing paper. You'll need FPP templates to make 2 blocks in class. Print the cutting and circle templates if you have the PDF pattern.
3. Cut one of each strip listed below or feel free to cut all of the strips listed in the pattern if you're making the quilt. Bring the remaining yellow fabric. WOF = width of fabric. Don't subcut the strips or cut any circles, we'll do that together during class.

### Yellow:

- (1) 4" x WOF strip
- (1) 4  $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strip
- (1) 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip

### White:

- (1) 6" x WOF strip
- (1) 4" x WOF strip
