Favorite Flavors & Curved Piecing Class Supply List

The great thing about the Favorite Flavors Pattern is that you can make a quilt with 1 to 6 small or big lollipops. Refer to the pattern for the finished sizes of each layout. The sample in the shop is made with the small lollipops. Before class, decide how many lollipops you want in your quilt and their size. I love to see what participants make! Materials:

- · Favorite Flavors Quilt Pattern: Purchase it at Christmas Goose
- · Fabric:
- · Amounts according to your chosen number and size of lollipops. Refer to the **Fabric Requirements** section of the pattern for yardages.
- · Starch and press the background, stick, and candy fabrics before cutting them. Starching is really important to have success with curved piecing.
- · Cut the background, stick, and candy fabrics according to the **Cut Fabrics** section of the pattern. Border and binding fabrics do not have to be cut prior to class.

- **Templates:** The templates are in the pattern. Cut out templates A, B, C, and D in either the small or large size.

Tools & Equipment:

- · Glue Pen such as Sewline's water soluble glue pen
- · Pins
- · Rotary cutter
- · Sewing machine
- \cdot Quarter inch foot if you use it for $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams
- · Coordinating or neutral thread for piecing
- · Seam ripper (just in case!)
- · Circle Savvy Ruler by Creative Grids, optional
- · Christmas Goose supplies irons, ironing boards, cutting mats, and acrylic rulers that you can use during class.
