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# Foundation Paper Piecing Basics Supply List

Hi! I am so excited to have you in this class! In this class, you'll learn how to do FPP using my series of FPP hexagon quilt block patterns. I designed these patterns to make learning and mastering this technique a breeze and you'll have gorgeous blocks in the end. You only need **one** of the patterns for the class.

## Materials:

- One Pattern, your choice from: Striped Hexi's, Equilateral Gone Awry, or Nuts About You
- 3 - 5 fabrics:  $\frac{1}{4}$  to  $\frac{1}{2}$  yd of each. Scraps also work well for this project. Fabrics that don't have a right side, like solids, are easier to learn FPP with but I will show you how to use prints too.
- 50 to 80 weight neutral or coordinating thread

## Tools & Equipment:

- Pencil
- Colored pencils in your fabric colors
- Paper scissors or a rotary cutter you use on paper
- Seam ripper (just in case!)
- Glue Pen such as Sewline's water soluble glue pen
- Pins
- Rotary cutter
- Add-a-Quarter ruler
- Cutting mat
- Sewing machine with a standard foot
- Quarter inch foot if you use it for  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams
- Seam Roller
- Tweezers

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
